Multicultural Scholars Program in the Social Sciences

The Multicultural Scholars Program in the Social Sciences is a comprehensive program of mentoring and social activities that requires my participation and involvement. To be eligible for a scholarship, I will follow the guidelines for the Program, as described below.

Full class attendance. If I miss a class, I will contact my professor before the class meets, if possible, or as soon as possible.

Full attendance at all mandatory group meetings. My scholarship amount for will depend partially on attendance at mandatory group meetings. Absences will be permitted only under severe and unusual circumstances. If you work, please change your schedule as soon as you receive notification of the mandatory meetings. Work schedules are not acceptable excuses for absences, not are exams that will be taken on the day following a meeting.

I will be prepared and on-time for one-on-one meetings with MSP staff members. This includes bringing completed academic forms, class syllabi, recent tests, papers, and any other relevant class materials to our meetings.

I will monitor my e-mail on a daily basis and respond promptly (same day) to MSP- messages. An active e-mail account is required to fulfill this aspect of the contract. If you do not have one, one of the MSP-staff members will help you establish one. Once established, you will notify the MSP- staff person responsible for academic monitoring any time you receive feedback on a test, quiz, exam, get a grade on a paper or project, or earn any other grades or points for an activity that contributes to your grade in each course you are taking.

I will be honest about all academic performance issues so that help can be arranged if the MSP- staff members this it is needed.

I will maintain a minimum grade-point average (GPA) of 2.5 per semester. Failure to maintain a 2.5 GPA will mean that I will be placed on probation for the next semester and receive no, or a reduced, scholarship at the discretion of the Directors of the MSP-program.

If I receive tutoring through the Program, I will attend each session that is scheduled, I will be on time, and I will be academically prepared for the session.

I will write a thank-you letter to the donor who provided this scholarship, as advised in my award notification letter.
